

The new RFID check-in and out system is up and running at the Maidu and Downtown branches with the expectation to be fully operational across the system between now and Spring.

Remember Roseville's library system operates using a 'floating collection' all the material(s) available for check out can be obtained using the online catalog from within the branches or remotely. This offers everyone a chance to reserve a copy of material you are interested in borrowing.

If you are interested in finding the most recent acquisitions follow these 5 steps:

- 1: Go to the library homepage.
- 2. Click on "find a book"
- 3. Then you have 2 options. a). click on "Advance Search" on the top left of the screen b).Or click on "browse for new items" using the drop down tab on the right hand side of the screen
- 4. If you use the "Advance Search", place a check mark in the box of your choice, scroll down and place a date range: (for example, 2014-; you must use the "dash" "-" located next to the zero on the keyboard) and click search. If you have questions, call or come into the branch for further assistance.
- 5. If you use the "Browse for New Items" drop down arrows you will see genres that you can search through.
