4. RCONA report:

He doesn't understand if this reflects a change in the age of the kids in the neighborhood or what. He didn't call the police because initially he didn't realize the severity of the damage.

Officer Hendrick pointed out that the last significant vandalism was seven or eight years ago. He also suggested that any vandalism be reported to the police so the incident can be provided to the analysis unit. Geoff will post this suggestion on Facebook

6. Library Report: The Library is going to put in a new computer system in the new fiscal year.


7. Old Business:
