

<u>Crime Corner - Crime Analysis</u>

At our February Maidu Neighborhood Association meeting, we enjoyed a presentation by Roseville Police Department Crime Analysts Amanda Wardelman and Jason Rudolph. As Crime Analysts, Amanda and Jason help patrolmen and detectives know where to target their policing to have the greatest effect. They base their recommendations on patterns they find in various data sources, communications with analysts in other departments, environmental factors and recent crime trends. They use computers to help them analyze crime data and statistical methods to make predictions about where crimes are most likely to occur.

The Crime Analysts also feed their recommendations directly to Roseville citizens. If you receive the Public Safety and Neighborhood News from the Roseville Police Department, many of the tips at the beginning of these newsletters come from the Crime Analysts. They've provided such topics as catalytic converter theft and mail theft warnings.

What was their number one tip? If you see anything suspicious, call it in! Your call may not result in an arrest that day, but the information you provide adds important data points they can use to predict and help solve crimes. Trust your gut. Call it in. The telephone number for Roseville Police is 774-5000.
