

Catalytic Converter Etching Program

Three auto service businesses in Roseville have stepped up to help stop catalytic converter thefts. If you own one of the frequently-targeted vehicles - - Toyota trucks, Toyota SUVs, or other trucks and SUVs that are high off the ground with accessible catalytic converters, then call Roseville Toyota, Firestone Auto Care on Washington Boulevard, or Napa Auto Care on Riverside, and schedule an appointment to have your catalytic converter etched and painted for free. The goal is to make your catalytic converter less attractive to thieves, harder for them to sell to metal recyclers, and easier for police to trace if it turns up in a scrap yard or in the hands of a suspected thief.

Roseville's crime rate was the lowest in 17 years which Police Chief Hahn attributes to Roseville residents and the police department working together.
