2. Special Presentation: Mark Murphy, Maidu Museum: Mark started by giving a bit of history regarding how he came to the museum.

The museum is now considered world class. Exhibits change on a regular basis. Mark touched on the recent exhibit of Maidu baskets and a show on the use of the American Indian as “mascots” by schools and other organizations.

The museum’s prize pieces are the petroglyphs found on the property. The best way to see them is by taking one of the lantern tours in the evening or observing them at sunrise or sunset.

Mark talked about some of the various activities including kids’ programs, docents, natural resources around the property, campfire storytelling, etc. Many of those involved are Native Americans.

Admission costs are \$4.50 for a museum tour and \$4.50 for the trail tour. This is for the students as well. Students are also required to pay for their transportations costs as well.

The museum will be moving out from under direct oversight by the Recreation Department and instead will be reporting to the new director of the library system. As a museum this is a better fit.

There are rooms available for rent from small rooms up to small conferences of about 100+.

The board will invite Mr. Murphy to attend a future meeting.
