3. Police Report (see attached): Ken asked about preventive measures when a resident is away from home. Officer Semenuk reinforced what we've heard at previous meetings, the importance of neighbors knowing and looking out for one another. Officer Stokes suggested motion detector lights are also helpful.

- a. Lieutenant Walstad noted there as been a number of auto window smashes at the mall and Miners' Ravine. Large items were taken. We should be alert as well for suspicious activity.
- b. He also state there has been an uptake in bike theft out of open garages. Owners should keep track of bike serial number so it can be reported as stolen. Most of these thieves are never charged because the bikes are never reported as stolen.
- c. He spoke to some local bad press which gave an inaccurate report on the state of drug/prostitution activities within Roseville. This came about as a result of the arrest of a retired Placer County Battalion Chief. The media didn't bother noting that he was retired.

5. Treasurer's report: The beginning October balance is \$2,190.71. The ending balance is \$2,076.63.

6. RCONA report:

- a. Bay Delta Conservation Plan: There will be a gathering at Folsom Lake the first week in November. The intent of the plan is to move Folsom water south. Mayor Rohan and other

water/lake advocates will be celebrating the Lake the week of November 4<sup>th</sup>. (see attached) The problem will also be discussed by the Mayor and others at the November 21<sup>st</sup> RCONA meeting at the Mahany Park.

- b. On November 4<sup>th</sup> 10:00 AM at the Maidu Community Center Senior Wing, there will be an informational meeting in conjunction with Roseville Police regarding current Senior Scams.
- c. The city is currently emphasizing neighborhood watch programs for small groups, 10-12 homes, etc. Liz Johnson offered to write an article on the subject as she is part of one such group in her own neighborhood. Geoff suggested we contact the city to see if they would be interested in giving a presentation on the program at a meeting after the first of the year.

09-24-2013          2:36 a.m.                  Officers responded to a complaint about loud music coming from a garage in the 2200 block of McLaren Drive. Officers responded and a resident came out holding a 2 X 4. He was arrested for being drunk in public.

09-30-2013          9:46 a.m.                  Officers responded to Maidu Elementary School at school official's request, regarding a parent who had approached another parent and was talking strangely (talking about military drones and such). He had already left the school by that time. Officers responded to the parent's home and talked to him, and took him to the hospital to be evaluated.

10-6-2013                  Residential burglary: Between 7 and 7:30 a.m. October 6, a home in the 2400 block of Valley Forge was burglarized while the residents were away. The burglar(s) broke a window in the back of the residence and stole jewelry and other items of value. A witness saw a white female adult and a white male adult in a gray four-door Chevy or Ford sedan in front of the house and carrying items during the timeframe of the burglary.

10-11-2013 Suspicious circumstances: At 3:45 a.m. officers responded to an alarm at a residence in the 2400 block of Valley Forge Way (not the same house as above). The first officer on scene saw a white truck being driven away at a high rate of speed. The home was secure, and the residents weren't home. A neighbor checked his security cameras, and saw an early 2000s model white extended cab pickup (possibly a Ford) with a lumber rack park in front of the house, and a person got out and walked toward the house. The vehicle was seen being driven away shortly afterwards. If this was a burglary attempt, it's possible the burglar was scared away by the audible alarm activation.

10-11-2013 Theft: At about 8:30 p.m., a woman set a cell phone down on the bleachers next to her during a softball game at Maidu Park, and it was stolen. She saw a man hurrying away from the bleachers right after the theft. She followed him, and he started running and got into a car (no further description) and left the park. He was described as a light-complexioned black male in his early 20s, 5'8 to 5'10 tall with a slim-to-athletic build, wearing a black BB cap, black shirt or hoodie, blue jeans and black Converse shoes.

10-13-2013 Vehicle burglary: Between 4 and 4:45 a.m., someone got into two vehicles in a driveway in the 1800 block of Balboa and took a video projector, tools, an iPod and other items of value. The resident believes both vehicles were locked. There was no sign of forced entry.

10-20-2013 At 1:20 a.m. a resident of the 1300 block of Ridgecrest Way was awakened by a loud thud, and heard the sound of bells she'd tied to the inside of her front door handle. Officers responded and found her front door had been kicked, and the door damaged but not breached.

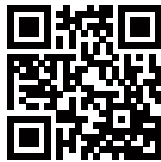

I recently distributed the statistics to the Board for most of this year, I had planned to talk about that at our October meeting. As you can see we are holding our own. The e-books/audio are increasing, with both OneClickDigital and Overdrive, offering e-books and audio now.

The library seems to be focusing much of their attention on fundraising for the Book Mobile. The hope is it will be up and running in early 2014. FOL has donated funds of which the library has allocated \$20,000.00 toward the book mobile. It is very unclear how much is left to be raised and all questions I have asked have been answered in vaguely w/o a real dollar amount. The amount the various groups, org., and general public was being asked to help with was \$50,000.00.

Much of the library programs seem to be shifting to Downtown with the literacy, historic, and the opening of the Roseville Plaza. I am not sure if the FOL book sales are quarterly or bi-monthly but those are also Downtown increasing their attendance. FOL will have their holiday book sale at Maidu Library 12/7 coinciding with the Craft Fair.
