2. Sign in/Welcome:

3. Police Report:

- a. There has been an increase in catalytic converter thefts. These are generally around commercial areas. This occurs less frequently in the neighborhoods. This hasn't been significant in the association area. In addition to the converters being taken from Toyotas, they are now being taken off diesel vehicles.
- b. There was a burglary off Ridge Crest. Two people were arrested over in that area. A woman had her phone stolen out of her purse in Hobby Lobby. (The purse was in her cart.) Everyone involved was arrested.
- c. In our area people are getting stuff stolen that are left out over night or strapped to the top of their cars.
- d. The police department is understaffed for a number of reasons, pay, morale, possibly losing pensions when leaving another agency. The department is down by seventeen officers down since 2005 while there as been an increase in population. The department is working on adding staff, Officer Van Deer Wende being an example of a recent hire.
- e. In late June, landscape equipment was stolen off the back of work trucks. Pool items and garden supplies where taken out of a backyard. A lot of the small item thefts are perpetrated by heron addicts.

7. Library Report:

- a. There have been no statistical reports for a while.
- b. There has been a new supervisory librarian and librarian hired.
- c. The summer reading program is coming to an end. There will be four prizes for adults, including a Nook. The hope is that 100,00 titles were read or listened to over the eight weeks.
- d. The Mystery club is now self managed. The Maidu club is splitting to two groups. This club's members choose the genre to be read. Fran hopes to add a non-fiction club.
- e. The money has bee raised for the Book Mobile. The city is holding off on an announcement until December when it will be delivered.

8. Old Business:

- a. National Night Out: Scott will send a couple of questions to Lance. What does he need from us, start time, fliers, set-up, drinks from Sam's Club, etc.? Shirley is bringing the photo album, sign-up sheets, and card tables. Jim will bring the Maidu Banner and KKAD25 signs. (In discussing the fliers delivery, David suggested, this would be a good time to build an email list of the Block Captains.)
- b. Updates on Park burn-area irrigation, restoration: Nothing
- c. Library Statistic Letter: Fran is going to follow-up with the system to see why she isn't getting the statistics and what is going on with them and with Maidu's. No further action will be taken on the letter until she gets back to us.
- d. Neighborhood Blood Drive: Nothing to report except Blood Source recently had a drive in the park.
- e. Another Doggie Bag Station at Maidu?: The cost is \$350 per station installed. David is opposed to adding a new one because he doesn't think it would help with the ongoing p**p problem. He suggested labeling mounds, "degusting," etc. might wake some people up. Jim noted that he had actually posted the ordnance along the stretch between John's Ranch and Winchester which significantly reduced the problem for a period of time. He suggested putting the ordinance in the park on the bag stations. Geoff asked if the cadets could "ticket." David will ask about the cadets and see if they can get involved. We will continue to talk about the issue and maybe following up on a combination of David and Jim's suggestions.

- a. Jim noted the newsletters are not current on the website but a few months behind. He is using them as examples for other neighborhood associations so he'd like to seem them brought up to date. Geoff also noted the minutes are not current.
