3. Police Report: Some of the older cluster mailboxes are more easily broken into but newer ones are better made.

- a. Vehicle and garage door burglaries still dominate crime reports.
- b. The new officers are being assigned to work with transients. It's part of problem oriented policing and police are partnered with Social Services Workers.
- c. City growth means the city is budgeting two more officers each year. The neighbor asked why it take so long to hire police. Officer Wilson explained that even for a lateral move, which is the easiest to do. it still takes at least 6 months to do background checks. From the time an officer enters the academy for the first time to becoming a fully functioning independent police officer takes at least 18 months and up to 2 years.
