3. Police Report:

- a. The city may go to one year shifts rather than six months. This would mean officers being assigned to the same beat for a year rather than the current six months.
- b. There is a small increase in residential burglaries citywide. This is continues to be primarily a result of people leaving their garage doors open.
- c. Officer Gaines mentioned the Crime Analyst. This individual provides predictive policing which has in turn had the effect of making the department more efficient. The police are able to use less resources in catching criminals.
- d. There has been an increase in solicitors going door-to-door. Residents are encouraged to see the solicitor's city permit which is required by city. If they don't have one call the police. The no solicitor sign can be downloaded at:

- e. There has been some increase in violent crime. Once again residents are encouraged to call the police when seeing suspicious individuals or activities.

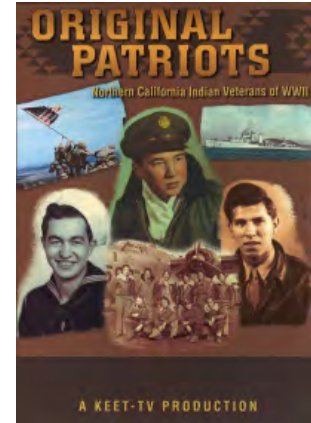
4. Minutes of Previous Meeting: Approved

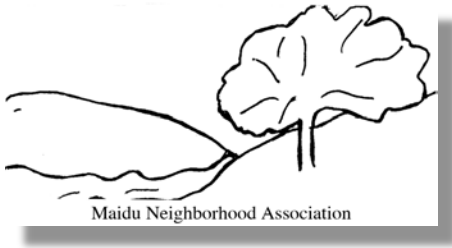


9. Old Business:
