3. Police Report:

- a. The city as a whole has had a drop in crime this last year. The city's numbers are lower than any of the surrounding community. Officer Gillespie says this is due to the vigilance of the neighbors. He reminded us to keep garage doors closed especially at night because of crimes of opportunity. Also remember to lock the side garage doors.
- b. Traffic accidents, especially DUI related, have gone up so there will be an increase in enforcement of speed limits. The speed trailers are being put out in a number of neighborhoods. These can also be used to identify when and where there is a significant problem. Accordingly increased enforcement will be set up in the specific areas. Traffic motorcycles will be a primary method of enforcement. There will also be an increased enforcement on signal and stop sign violations.
- c. The city, in the next few months, will provide a way for those with security cameras on their homes to register with the city. Recordings from these sources may be of help in specific crimes where they may have been caught by these cameras.

4. Fire Department Report:

- a. Fire Captain Tilton said one thing that really helps the Fire Department is to make sure the house number is visible from the street both day and night.
- b. Fran asked how we can help if we see somebody disoriented? This came from an incident in which she was trying to help someone who was. Captain Tilton said to call 911 and

make sure to say this is a medical emergency as the person is disoriented. Fran noted to look to see if there is a medical bracelet.

- c. Movie in the Park: July 22nd 6:30 – 10:00 PM. Volunteers needed for this event.

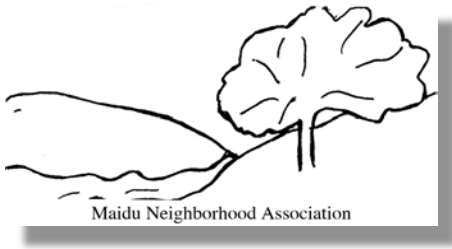
8. Old Business:
