3. Police Report:

- a. Officer Haley will be our beat officer through the end of the year.
- b. He asked that if we have issues to contact him directly.
His email is jhaley@roseville.ca.us. The department has already solved some issues for the Cirby Ranch NA as a result of being contacted directly.
- c. The most important thing neighbors can do is to look out for one another because of the “craziness” that is going on. Roseville is an attractive city for criminals. And community alertness is therefore vital.
- d. The police did catch an individual based on the information they received from a neighbor. Accordingly, he reminded us that the more detailed information we can provide the greater benefit to the police and their safety.
- e. Break-ins have increased on the east side of the city. This is tied to recent changes to laws that have weakened the consequences of crime. The “Safety for All Act” will be coming out on the ballot. This expands on the impact already created by “Prop 47” which lets out more criminals based on a weak definition of the seriousness of some crimes. It is these released criminals who are often responsible for the increased number of break-ins. They aren’t terribly concerned about consequences.
- f. The department has no information on the two gunman that recently caused a massive traffic tie up last week.

5. Treasurer's Report: The beginning June balance was \$2,269.40. The ending June balance is \$2,169.40.

- ii. Re food, Buck and Sadie's may or may not show up. Jimmy John's will be showing up. Jim will get salad makings, plates, napkins and water from Sam's Club. Geoff will bring serving pieces. Lance recommends that we go ahead and get food for 125. We'll go with L & L for catering. Kona Ice will be there to sell snow cones.

9. New Business:

- a. Fence at Sargeant School: Chris Kraft spoke to the problem. He has lived in a home next to the park for 20 years. The school as put up a large locked fence a few weeks back. This has significantly impacted access to the park and it's equipment. (This has happened at 18 schools in the Roseville School District.)

While concern over safety of students is certainly legitimate to prevent the public from access appears to be overkill. Certainly during the summer the area does not need to be cut off. And when school is in session it could certainly be locked but left open at other times.

Mr. Kraft has contacted the school district to inform them this is contrary to the joint agreement with the city. In "protecting" the students they have locked out the people. The

Superintendent contacted him and the school board will be speaking with the city. He is going to try to get it on the School District board meeting agenda on the 11th. This will be on 1050 Main Street at 6:00 pm. He will come to the August meeting and report what happens. (see attached)

Depending on the results of this RCONA may get involved since this is a city-wide issue.

- b. Board Elections: The slate currently includes Scott, Lance, Fran, Dave and Mary. Lance does not intend to run but has someone he is trying to get to come on. Dave also wants off. We don't know about Fran so Scott will talk to both. We will try to firm up the slate prior to the newsletter.
