3. Police Report:
 - a. The most common activity is typically tied to the holidays. This includes: Package thefts and thefts from vehicles. There was also a house break in on Thistle Down.

 - e. There will be extra patrols, undercover, during the holiday season. These will be stationed around shopping areas to be on the look out for thieves. There will also be extra DUI enforcement going on during the weekends. We were advised to call "911" when observing a driver who appears under the influence.

8. Old Business:

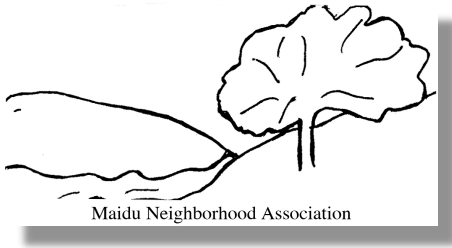
- a. Website Subcommittee Report: Nothing to report at this time.
