1. Meeting called to order at: 7:07 PM
2. Sign in/Welcome
3. Police Report:
  - a. Crime trends from 2016-2017 are pretty stable level in all types of crime with the exception of an increase in petty thefts. These are done by individuals who check house doors to see if they are open. Officer Gillespie reminded us to make sure house and car doors are locked and everything in the car is hidden including the garage door openers.
  - b. The department is putting out bait cars because of uptick in car burglaries in parking lots. These cars have merchandise with GPS trackers on them. While there hasn't been huge results they did catch five people from Olive Hurst.
  - c. Speaking of accidents at intersections the officer noted that Sunrise and Cirby used to be the intersection with the most accidents. Because of a significant increase in traffic control at this spot there has been a decline in accident there. Accordingly Riverside and Cirby/Melody Lane is now the number one problem area. Part of the problem here is due to the layout of lights which have been adjusted to try to reduce the problem.
  - d. At the moment mail box thefts are down though activity does go up and down. The bulk of activity is happening at cluster mailboxes. On the other hand package theft is tied to individual homes.
4. Minutes of Previous Meeting: No quorum so not acted on.
5. Treasurer's Report: The ending January balance was \$1,363.81. The ending February balance is \$1,363.81
