2. Sign in/Welcome

3. Police Report: None

4. Minutes of Previous Meeting:

Motion BM 8/18-1: Motion: The minutes be approved. Ken moved, Scott seconded. Approved.

5. Treasurer's Report: The ending July balance was \$2,124.03. The August balance as of this date is \$2,124.03

6. RCONA:

a. There will be a city Goals Workshop on September 4th at Maidu Community Center 6:30-8:30 pm. There are two parts to the workshop. One part focuses on the sales tax increase, Measure B, passing. The other will focus on consequences of it not passing.

b. Jim reminded to the board of the need to respond to the RCONA survey. Currently we are in the lead with four board members participating.

7. Old Business:

a. National Night Out: National Neighborhood Day would be September 16th. The question was do we want to participate? After a short discussion the consensus was not to go ahead this year because a Sunday event was problematical and there wasn't enough time to gear up again. Additionally it was decided to continue to do NNO in August next year.

- b. Guest Speaker: Dominic Casey is scheduled for the October meeting. He's the new city manager and will speak on Measure B. He won't be pushing for a vote for it but rather just providing information on it from the city's perspective.

8. New Business:

- a. Park Cleanup: The event is scheduled for October 6th 10:00-1:00 pm. Jim will get the food and trash bags; Vicki will provide Ice Chests; Shirley will provide tables, Mary will get two \$25 Target gift cards.
- b. Elections Slate: Alan Bartley was willing to be added to the slate. Accordingly, Mary Hoff's term was extended through next year. This will allow for 5 board members to be up for election each year.

Motion BM 8/18-2: Motion: The slate as finalized — Ken Nitschke, Mary Steele, Dave Steele, Scott Reid and Alan Bartley. Geoff moved, Jim seconded. Approved.

- c. Placer County Sports & Events Center: The city wants to make sure people are informed about this project. Geoff put the information on Facebook. Jim will place it on the website and Scott will put it up on Nextdoor.
- d. Candidates Forum: There will be a candidates form at the Randy Peters Event Center, Vernon St., on Tuesday, September 11 from 6:15-8:30 pm. The information is available on our website.

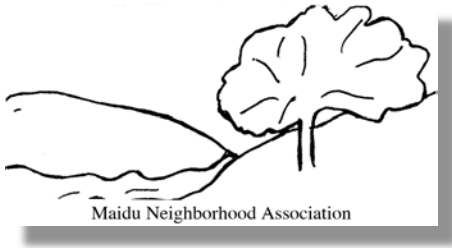
