2. Sign in/Welcome
3. Police Report:
  - a. This beat that encompasses our association is still one of the quietest in the city. All that goes on is just the usual property type of crimes.
  - b. No door kick in robberies have been occurring and mail thefts are down.
  - c. A number of bank robberies have occurred over the last three months.
  - d. The hotspots for crime in the area are on the corridor from the Centaury 14 up to the UA Theater and Chicago Fire parking lots. These are the usual car smash and grab. They generally occur round the dinner hour.
  - e. Speaking to Props 47 and 57, Officer Williams noted they have made it very difficult to deal with drug offenders. Where individuals would have been charged with felonies now the “crimes” are all misdemeanors and abusers receive a ticket. This has made their jobs more difficult. Even sellers know how to play the game.
  - f. The city continues to provide social service to those among the homeless who want them. Unfortunately this group is made up of those who mental health issues, those who have no interest in getting help as they want to live off the grid. It seems only a small portion actually want help. There are two transient officers in the city. And even when camps are broken up they simply move to another location.
  - g. Mary H noted that there are young men using the pavilion during the day for using drugs, etc. The police are aware of this but as noted above it is hard to doing anything about the problem.

7. Old Business:

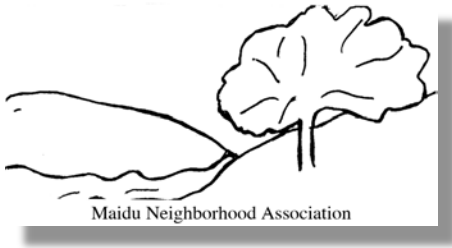
- a. Alexandra from CoRY (Coalition of Roseville Youth): We would like to schedule her for the May meeting if she and her staff are available.
