2. Sign in/Welcome

3. Police Report:

- i. Residential burglaries are up 9%. They just caught 3 individuals during a home break-in tonight in our beat. Auto burglaries are up 7% (both figures are citywide and reflect property crimes.) Violent crimes aren't up.
- ii. The officer reiterated the need for keeping cars locked, garage doors down. He also suggested taking a picture of the serial numbers on bikes which can help in recovery. He also said to do this for large ticket serialized items in the home for the same reason.
- iii. Store parking lots are frequently a place for auto break-ins so make sure all valuables are in the trunk. Better yet take large purchases home immediately. Shoppers need to be mindful of their surroundings.
- iv. We were reminded that if we see something that looks suspicious call it into the non-emergency number, (916) 774-5000. Too often people don't want to call and so crimes can occur. The 3 caught, noted above, was due to a vigilant neighbor who called in seeing something suspicious.

7. Old Business:

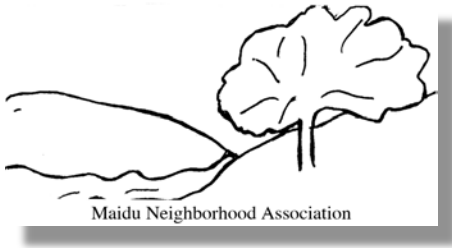
