Each district has to have approximately 1/5th of city population. There is a map on the RCONA website which is intended to help with the process. A significant issue is the census being used is from 2010. This means the whole process will have to be redone in 2021 when the results of the 2020 census become available..

As an aside this process also has the possibility of splitting NAs into different districts. This might or might not be a problem.

This month's council will provide a forum to discuss the issue.

RCONA has only started to discuss the issue.
