3. Minutes of Previous Meeting:

Motion BM 7/20-1: Motion: The minutes be approved. Vickie moved, Mary H. seconded. Approved.

4. Treasurer's Report: The ending June balance was \$1,973.59. The July balance as of this date is \$1,973.59. Garage Sale checks are being held.

5. RCONA:

b. Fireworks Booth: We had two booths. All information here is unofficial until the numbers are finalized. The booths did combined sales of \$232,000. RCONA will get around \$30,000. The neighborhood associations will divide up \$18,000. We should get a check of around \$2,820. These figures are much higher than last year. This would be do to lack of community fireworks programs.

6. Old Business:

a. Logo: We did get a submission from one of the neighbors. Scott will have to follow-up with the individual regarding any expectation of compensation. Once we have clarity we resend this and the logo #2 so we can finalize our decision in August. We'll use the Oak Tree in the profile slot on the Facebook page.

- c. Garage Sale: Mary said only 12 have currently signed up. Normally we get most sign up in the two weeks prior to this. We will probably go ahead unless the county shuts down.

- a. Rezoning Near North Cirby: Alan feels it's none of our business. We don't take positions on these type of issues. Scott noted that we have been a forum in the past for neighborhood discussion of these types of issues. But that's nothing we can do this year about setting up meetings. Mary H wondered if we could facilitate a meeting with the city on the site. Scott will follow up on this with the head of planning on the project.
