1. Meeting called to order at: 7:01 PM
2. Sign in/Welcome:
3. Police Report:
 - a. Vehicle burglaries still the highest crime. This is the same in our beat, Beat 2.
 - b. There is an increase in vandalism in Maidu Park including along the creek area, but it is mostly in the area of the covered soccer/hockey rink.
 - c. There has also been a rise in Catalytic Converter thefts.
 - d. Officer Kahler suggested, as a way of dealing with crime in general: report to the police, keep garage doors closed, know your neighbors, etc.
 - e. Question regarding the burning candles in the park. Police are patrolling more frequently in the area.
 - f. Question why so many police cars are out on Sunday morning at Sunrise/Cirby – this is to increase traffic enforcement.
4. Fire Department Report:
 - a. Ms. Garrett said the department was concerned for the incoming storm and the high winds, but not about flooding.
 - b. She gave a safety tip: Keep 3' distance around space heaters, keep chimneys maintained.
 - c. Help those who need it in getting through the Covid vaccine process.
5. Minutes of November Meeting:

Motion BM 1/21-1: Motion: Minutes be approved. Vicki moved, Scott seconded. Approved.

6. Treasurer's Report: The ending November balance was \$3,921.37. The January balance as of this date is \$3,855.60.

7. RCONA:

- a. Budget for 2021 approved including the floating \$100.
- b. When people can gather again one giant movie in the park is being considered.
- c. Next month's guest speaker will be the FBI.

8. Old Business:

- a. Christmas Decoration Recap: The event went well. It was suggested asking people to submit their desire to be entered into the contest using an online form. David Allen said he'd look into setting up a form. Alan suggested asking the block captains to nominate someone.
- b. Digging in the Park: Shirley is working on setting up a meeting with the city to explore options for kids who want to ride bikes on ramps; perhaps, their own bike ramp area or some "bike only" hours at the existing skate area. She has had a few people who want to join the meeting with the city including Eric Dexter and Tara Gee. David wants to be included. There was additional discussion. There are also two deserted streets in the Linda Creek area which could be a possible alternate site for the bike riders.
- c. Storage: Alan suggested getting the storage area by the batting cages. Jim thinks this will probably be rejected because all the other Neighborhood Associations would also ask for storage. Alan suggested, as an alternative, asking to put a Tuff Shed there. The third suggestion was using the portable by the Indian Center, but that is being currently being used for Covid testing.
- d. Business Cards: Scott is recommending using the original logo, i.e. the acorn and oak leaf, for the business card. This was fine with everyone.

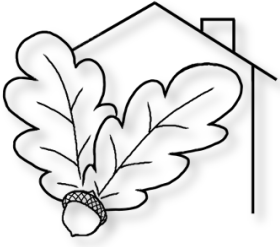
9. New Business:
