Monthly Meeting Minutes

June 2025

Date of Meeting: June 24, 2025

Time of Meeting: Maidu Neighborhood Association (MNA) meeting called to order by President Mary Steele at 6:33 p.m. at the Steele residence due to summer break at Sargeant School.

prior meeting: Meeting minutes from the May meeting were approved.

Treasurer's  
Report: Shirey Brown reported \$4,460.58 as the current account balance.

RCONA report: Jim Kidd reported the following topics related to RCONA activities:

- RCONA is offering \$4,000 grants every six months to affiliated Roseville neighborhood associations who apply. The MNA plans to apply for an RCONA grant to fund the costs for a pop-up canopy with the MNA logo

printed on it to be used for future events.

Old Business:

Pancake Breakfast Review: Total costs were \$71.53. The low cost for this year's event was partly due to using existing supplies of paper plates, cups, etc. and donations provided by local businesses. No Police or Fire Department staff were present to help serve pancakes; however, overall feedback was positive. The total participation was estimated to be 40 people (including MNA board members and family). The turnout was less than hoped for and is consistent with recent past years breakfasts. The Board discussed the viability of this event in the future and ideas of future pancake breakfasts. Ideas included offering games, activities, music, and changing the date and/or time to earlier in the morning. The Board discussed an interest with getting feedback from neighbors including an idea of distributing a survey insert with a future monthly newsletter. Mary Steele emphasized more support is needed if future breakfasts are offered but the Board was split whether or not to do it with most choosing to discontinue it.

18-unit Apartment Complex on Rocky Ridge Drive: Lance updated the Board indicating an appointment with the City Engineering staff is scheduled on July 22<sup>nd</sup>. Lance plans to meet with Mark Johnson to learn more about the city's 2020 Base Travel Demand Model which was used for evaluating future traffic conditions relative to the apartment project.

New Business:

MNA Board, Name Badges: Jim provided samples of 3 different name badges (used at RCONA) for MNA Board members to wear at future events. The badges would help provide better visibility of Board members for neighbors participating at MNA events. The Board voted 5-2 (with two abstentions) for lanyard style name badges with printable information. Moody was assigned to get cost estimates which could be included in the grant proposal for RCONA.

2025 MNA Board Elections: Jim sent an email to the MNA Board members prior to the meeting regarding MNA Bylaws concerning the timing of MNA elections. The Board discussed Jim's concern that the current Bylaws Section 2 do not specify what month elections are to be held. Jim proposed updating the Bylaws to be more specific when annual elections are held and the timing of related processes leading up to elections.

National Night Out 2025: National Night Out (NNO) 2025 is planned for Tuesday, August 5, 2025 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Maidu Park pavilion area. The Board discussed ideas for food, business participation, and tasks. Mary Steele made task assignments in preparation for this event.

Location of July 2025 Meeting: Mary Steele told Board members to plan attending the July meeting at her residence again.
