Monthly Meeting Minutes

April 2026

Date of Meeting: April 28, 2026

Time and Location of Meeting: Maidu Neighborhood Association (MNA) meeting called to order by Secretary Lance Hibben (President and Vice President unable to attend) at 6:37 p.m. at Sargeant Elementary School.

Roseville Police Dept. Report:

Roseville Police Officer Hancock attended the meeting to offer a Question-and-Answer opportunity. Officer Hancock responded to a question regarding a vehicle fire at Cirby and Sunrise indicating a traffic accident was not involved (the vehicle caught fire from internal reasons but was unclear if it was an electric vehicle or not). Officer Hancock spoke generally about e-bikes but was informed Sargent Mike Ryland has provided our neighbors updates the past two months in a row. Officer Hancock responded to a question why one of the Maidu Park baseball fields was being worked on. He informed attendees a vandal drove his four-wheel drive truck onto Field #4 causing extensive damages but was later apprehended and charged with additional crimes. Recently, vehicle thefts have increased in West Roseville areas. New Police Chief Jeff Beigh (pronounced Bee) begins his first day on April 29th. Officer Hancock also shared his background beginning in an Explorer program (Scouting) later becoming a Police Cadet. Since graduating from the Academy, he has been an Officer for the City of Roseville the past three years.

Roseville Fire Dept. Report

No report available.

Guest Speaker(s): No guest speakers this month.

Minutes from prior meeting: Meeting minutes from the March 2026 meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Shirley Brown reported \$3,810.67 as the current account balance. This balance included receipts (and donations of \$80) associated with the annual garage sale event.

RCONA report: Jim Kidd reported there was no scheduled board meeting for the Roseville Coalition of Neighborhood Associations (RCONA) due to their Sweet Celebrations event.

Visitor Forum: No new topics were presented.

Old Business: Annual MNA Neighborhood Garage Sale: The event date is set for May 2, 2026. Final preparations and tasks were discussed and assigned.

Feedback Regarding RCONA Sweet Celebrations Event: Like the prior year, the MNA paid for a table with MNA board members and guests in attendance. At the April MNA meeting, overall feedback about the event was less favorable than the prior year. Concerns about the food, lack of bidders for donated prizes, and redundancy of introductory information about awardees was unnecessary with the information presented in the program handout. There was an opportunity to provide better recognition of corporate sponsors. The facility received favorable comments. Meeting attendees felt hesitancy about participating next year.

RCONA-MNA Polo Shirts: Jim reported the polo shirts were distributed and received feedback from board members.

Maidu Regional Park: City of Roseville Parks and Recreation staff hosted a public presentation and request for feedback on April 9, 2026. Jim Kid and Susie Williams from the MNA Board attended the presentation and reported an update concerning the plans for the defunct batting cage area (closed in 2008). Based on feedback and research, city staff are moving towards redeveloping this area for two pickleball courts and two batting tunnels. More details are available on the city website.

New Business: Pancake Breakfast: The Pancake Breakfast slated for the day before Father's Day (Saturday, June 20th) included a discussion whether to host the event or not. Based on last year's feedback which was read from the June 2025 meeting minutes, further discussion, debate, and a vote took place. The vote results were split but the overall decision was to host another Pancake Breakfast in 2026. Based on last year's feedback, ideas to enhance the breakfast were discussed including offering yard games, musical talent (e.g. High School band), and beginning earlier in the morning (8:30-10:30). Jim will reserve the space within Maidu Park and Susie will contact the Granite Bay High School band. A budget was voted and approved for \$200 with Board member Moody Boulos as coordinator for the breakfast.

National Night Out 2026: Jim Kidd reported the MNA registration for the Tuesday, August 4, 2026 event has been completed. Vicki Miller and Mary Hoff were recommended to coordinate this year's event.

Landscaping Improvements on Rocky Ridge Drive: Shirley Brown raised awareness of the landscaping improvements made to both sides of Rocky Ridge Drive between Professional Drive and Mallard Lane. The landscaping improvements significantly improve the aesthetics of the western boarder of Maidu neighborhood boundary. Shirley and Lance Hibben volunteered to identify which city department coordinated this project and to offer appreciation and recognition on behalf of the MNA to the Roseville City Council.
